What is a stem-and-leaf plot?

A stem-and-leaf plot is a graphical representation of a dataset that shows the distribution of data. It is useful for quickly summarizing and visualizing data, especially for small to moderate-sized datasets.

In a stem-and-leaf plot, the "stem" represents the first digit or digits of the data values, and the "leaves" represent the remaining digits. Each leaf corresponds to a single data value. For example, if the stem is "5" and the leaf is "2", it would represent a data value of 52.

While a stem-and-leaf plot provides information on the shape of the data, such as the range of values and the distribution, it does not show the individual data values directly. Instead, it groups them into bins based on the stem and leaf representation. To get the actual values, one needs to refer to the original dataset.
